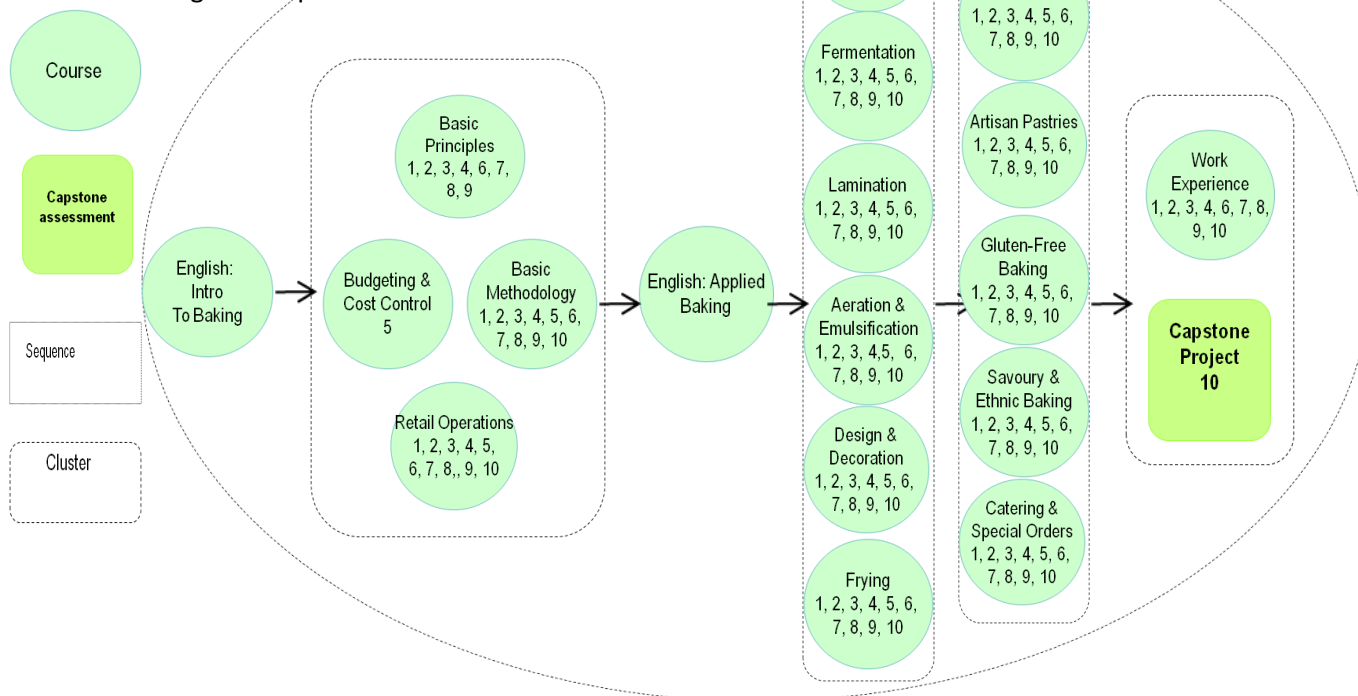

**Career Prospects**

Qualified graduates may be eligible for a post graduation work permit. Baking and Pastry Arts graduates who have a post graduation work permit, may find employment in retail bakeries, supermarkets, department stores, artisan bakeries, hotels, camps and other food related businesses in roles such as commercial baker, pastry cook, artisan baker, retail bakery salesperson. Some graduates could also operate their own bakery businesses.
