Description

The Bachelor of Applied Music is a full-time program. Most classes are scheduled Monday to Friday from 08:30 to 16:30, but evenings and weekends are sometimes required for rehearsals, performances and other activities. A combination of classroom instruction, lab activities, rehearsals, performances, work experience and practicum are included in the program.

Note: Courses offered in the degree program are normally limited to students who have been admitted to the Bachelor of Applied Music. From time to time the School of Music may grant permission for other students to access some of the degree courses.

How to Apply

\$125 CAD non-refundable application/audition fee:

Successful completion of the VCC Music Diploma or equivalent with a minimum B average and minimum A- in specialized performance or academic area is required prior to applying to the Bachelor of Applied Music degree program.

If you are applying for VCC Music – Bachelor Degree with transcripts awarded from other educational institutions, please submit the following documents to: VCC School of Music VCC - Broadway Campus, 1155 E Broadway, Vancouver, BC, V5T 4V5.

Transcripts: You will also need to submit your high school and/or university transcripts and proof of a TOEFL score of 550 or higher (213 computer based) taken in the last calendar year, IELTS score of 6.5 on the academic module with no band less than 6.0, a minimum score of 145/200 on the VCC English Language Assessment, or proof of English 12 taken in Canada.

Audition & Exam: You may send an audition DVD if you are living outside of Vancouver and cannot come in person for an audition. Arrangements may also be made to write the theory placement exam in your country.

Tuition: If you are accepted into the program, you will be required to pay a \$500 CAD non-refundable deposit. This will be deducted from tuition fees at the fall term registration, which takes place toward the end of August. Tuition fees for music courses are approximately CAD\$ 350 per credit.

Course Credits: Full-time students must take required credits per term. An average full-time term consists of 17 - 20 credits; however, reduced loads are considered with permission from the Department Head of the School of Music.
