Description

The Music Diploma Program provides professional training for potential and practicing musicians. It also provides necessary courses of instruction for performance-oriented students who may wish to pursue their studies at a more advanced level following the completion of the college program.

Major Study

Required courses (including individual instruction, ensembles and pedagogic studies) vary according to the student's major instrument and/or chosen area of specialization.

All full-time students choose a discipline for major study from the following:*

1. Instrumental Studies
2. Composition
3. Classical Voice
4. Jazz and Contemporary Voice
5. Composition/Arranging
6. Keyboard Studies
7. Jazz and Contemporary Instrumental Music

Transcripts: You will also need to submit your high school and/or university transcripts and proof of a TOEFL score of 550 or higher (213 computer based) **taken in the last calendar year**, IELTS score of 6.5 on the academic module with no band less than 6.0, a minimum score of 145/200 on the VCC English Language Assessment, or proof of English 12 taken in Canada.

Audition & Exam: You may send an audition videotape or CD if you are living outside of Vancouver and cannot come in person for an audition. Arrangements can also be made to write the theory placement exam in your country.

Tuition: If you are accepted into the program, you will be required to pay a \$500 CAD non-refundable deposit. This will be deducted from tuition fees at the fall term registration, which takes place toward the end of August. Tuition fee for Music Diploma is approx. CAD\$ 350 per credit

Course Credits: Full-time students must take a minimum of 12 credits per term, but are advised that taking less than an average load means it will take longer than two years to earn the diploma. An average full-time term consists of 17 - 21 credits; however, reduced loads are considered with permission from the Department Head of the School of Music.
