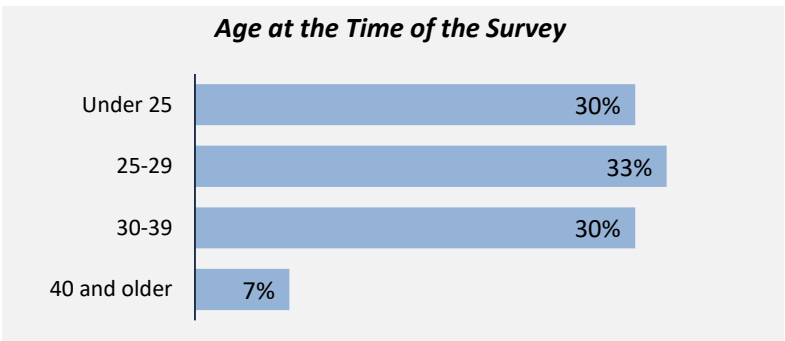
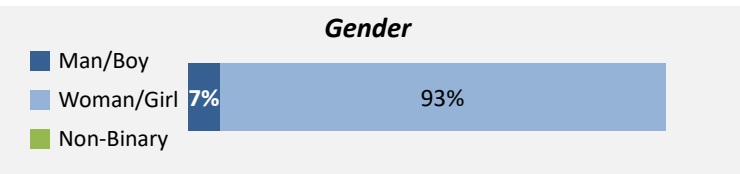

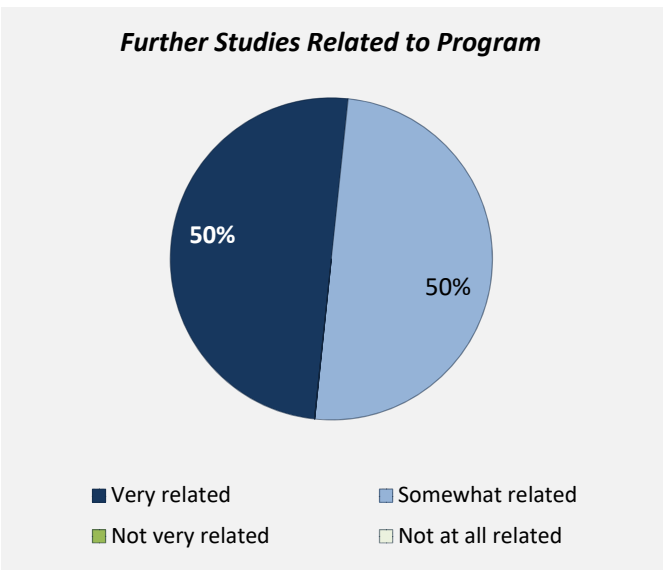

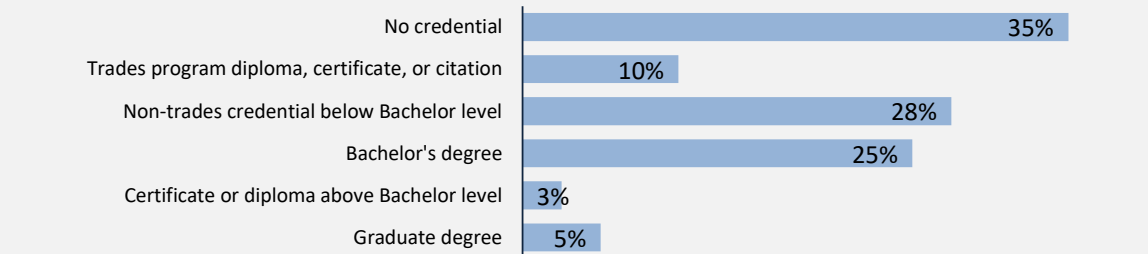

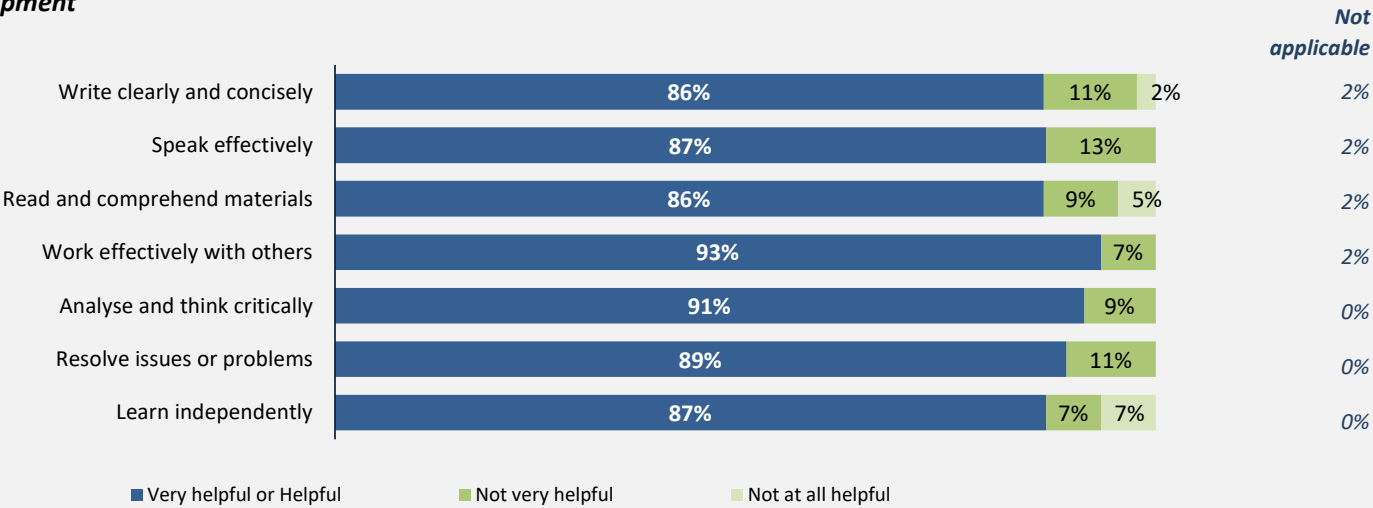

Skill Development and Post-Secondary Experience

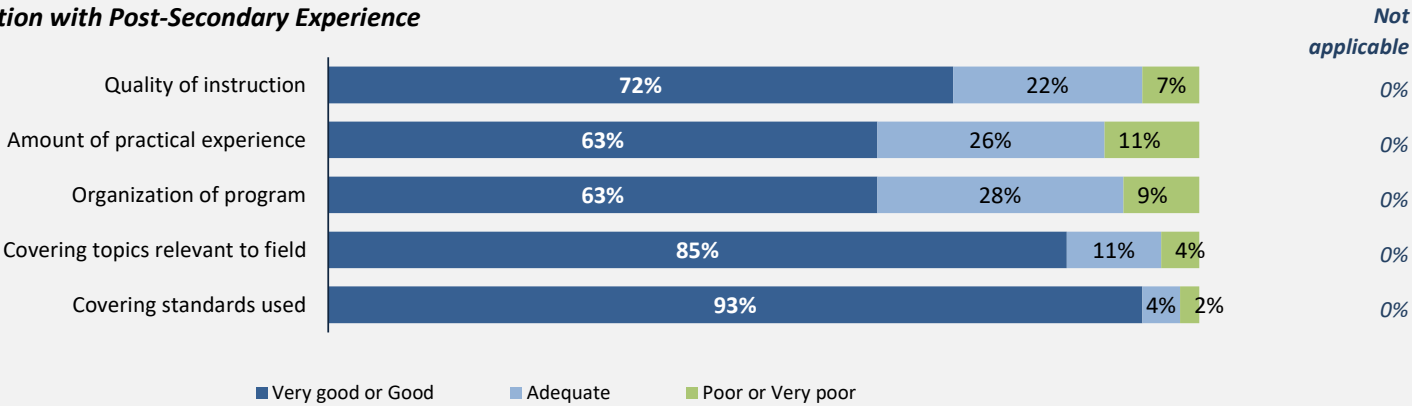
89% said they were very satisfied or satisfied with the education they received.
