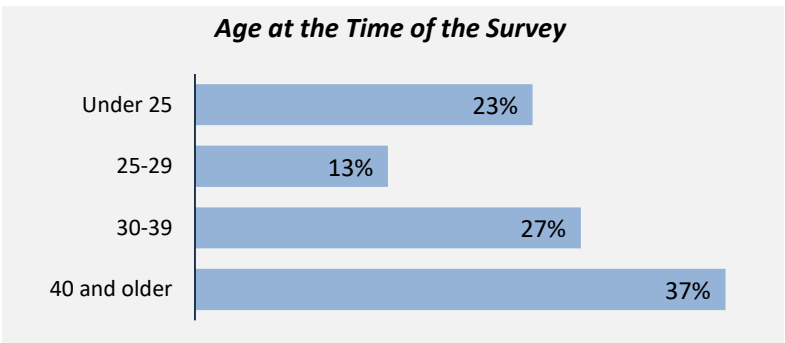

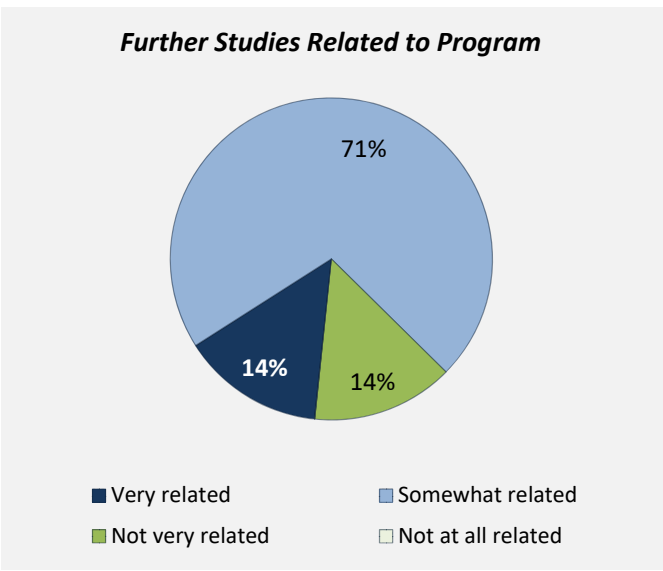

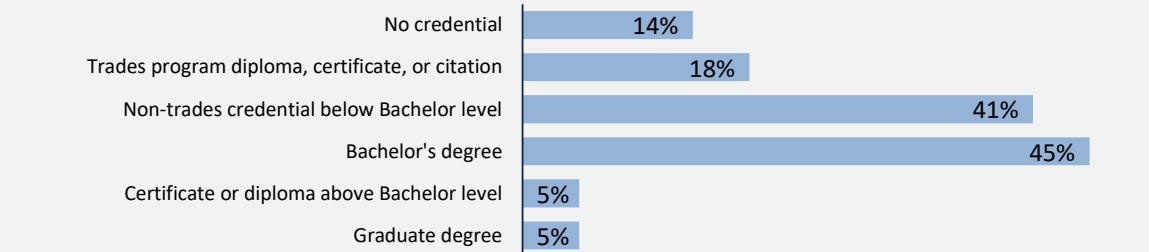

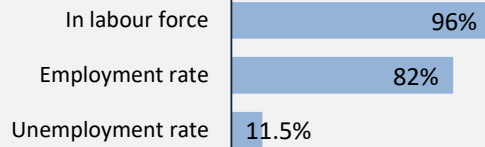

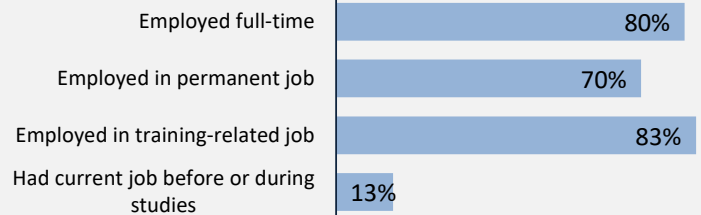
## Employment Outcomes

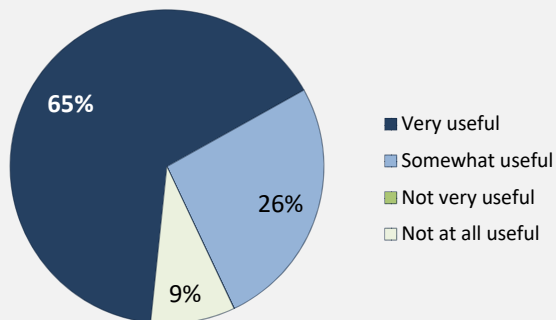

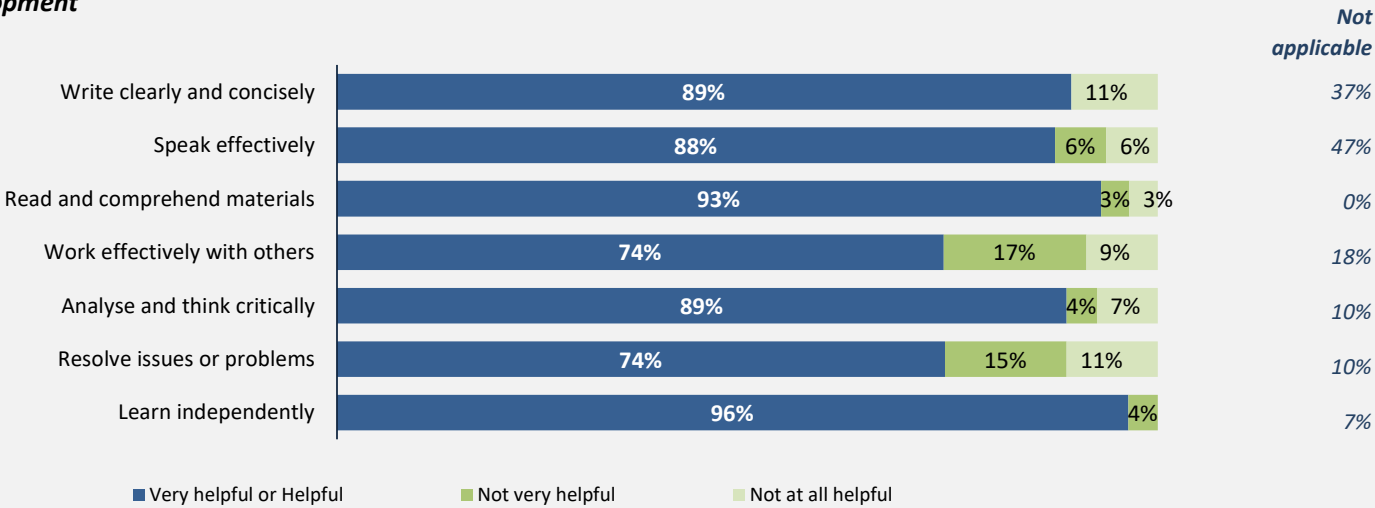

Skill Development and Post-Secondary Experience

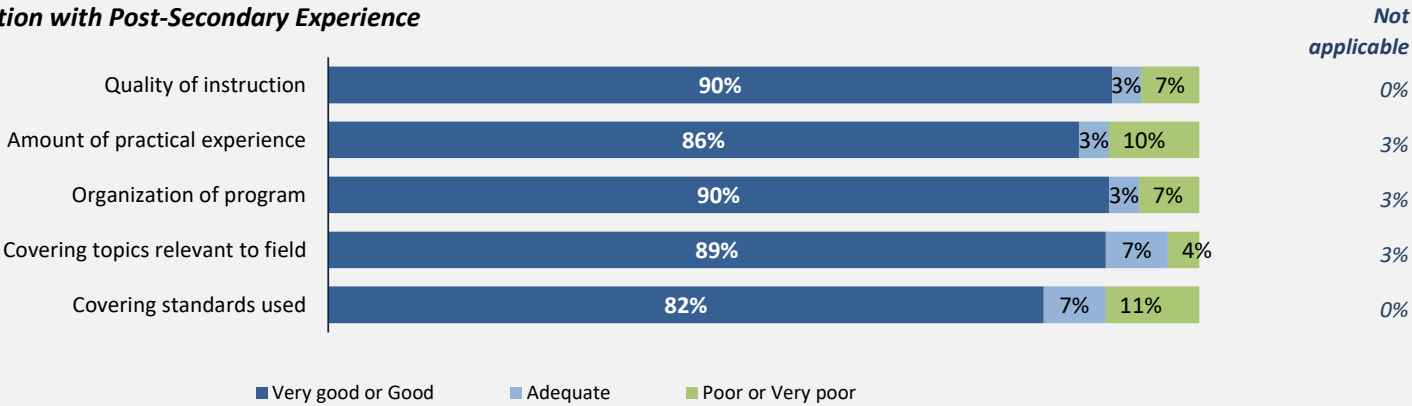
87% said they were very satisfied or satisfied with the education they received.
