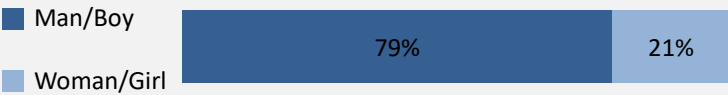

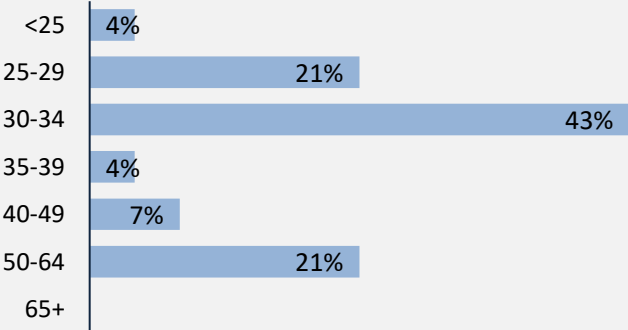

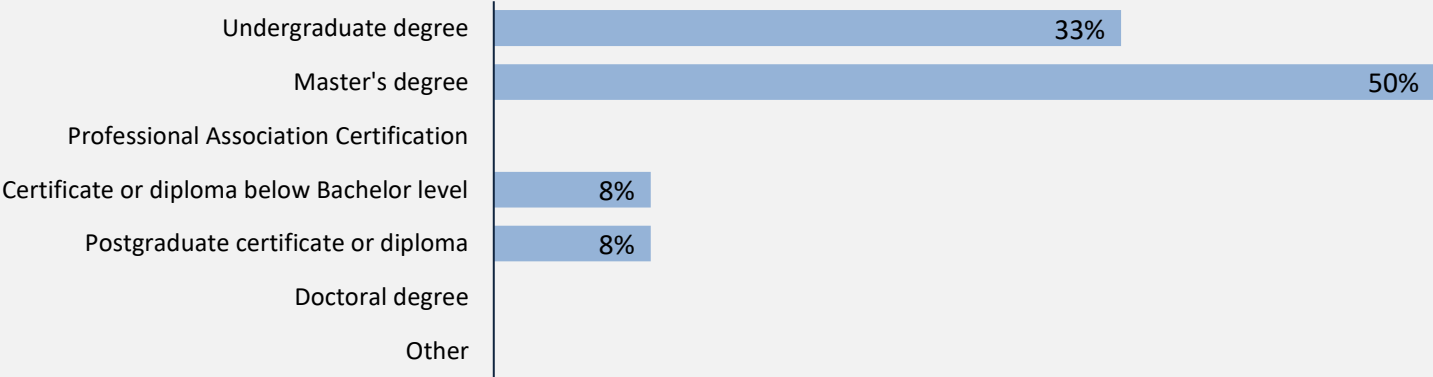

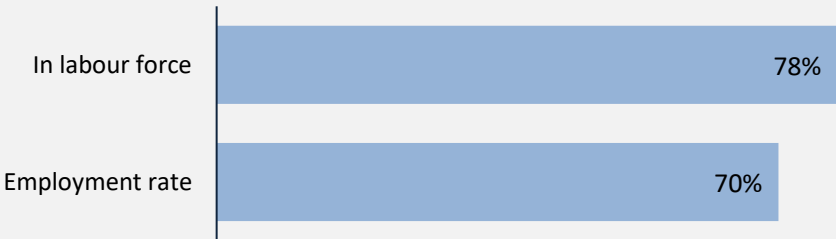

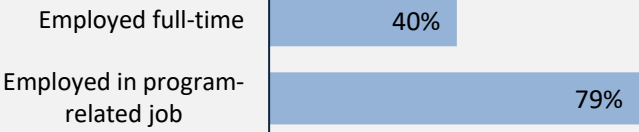

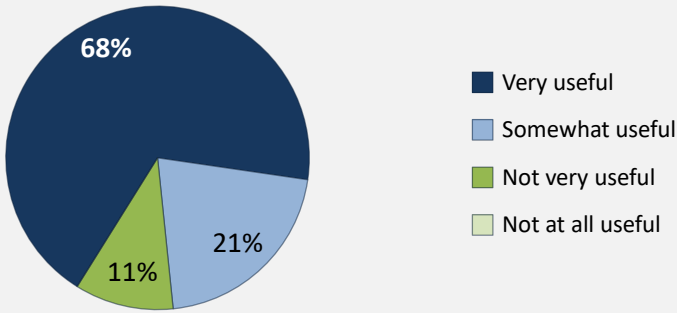

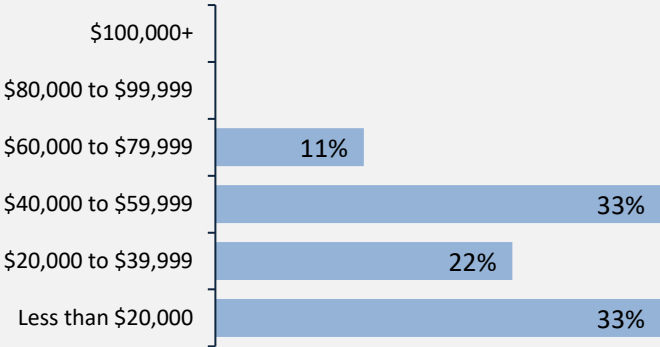

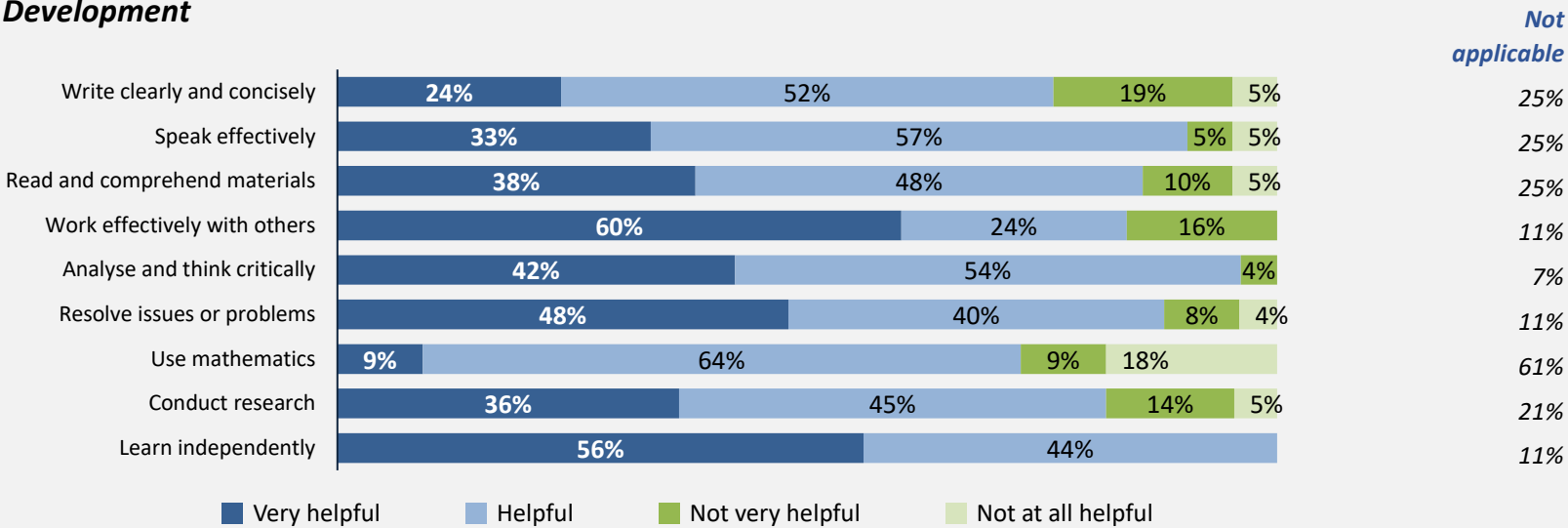

Skill Development and Post-Secondary Experience

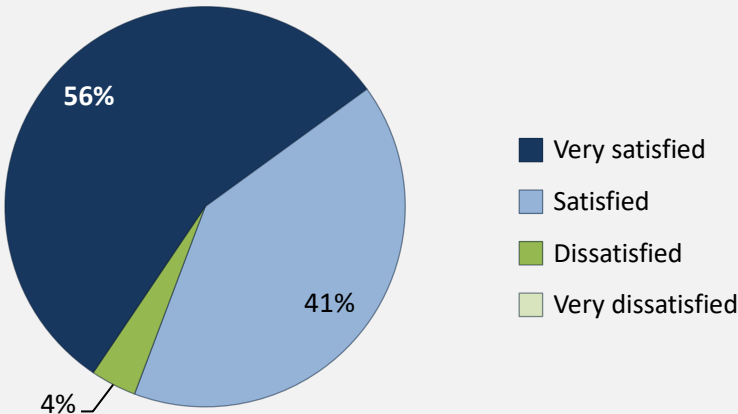
84% of respondents said they would choose the same program again
