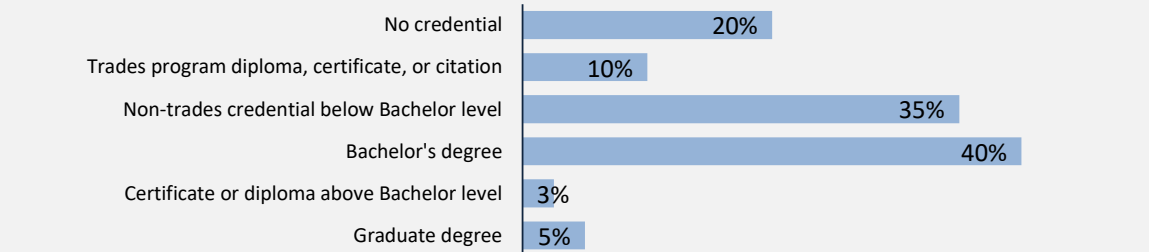

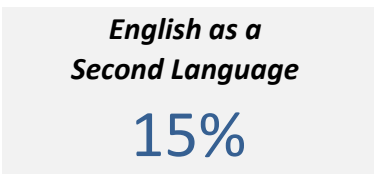
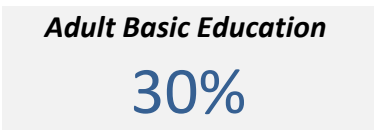


Past Education

Respondents were asked if they took ABE or ESL courses during or prior to their studies

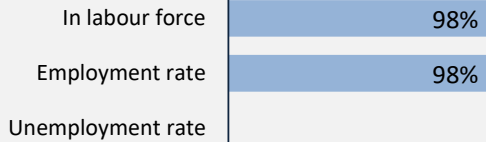

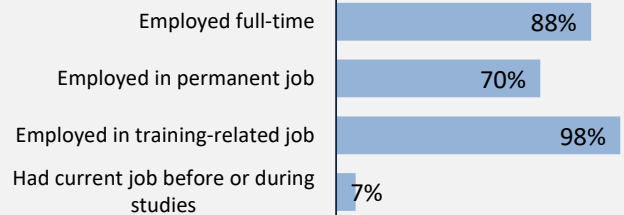
Employment Outcomes

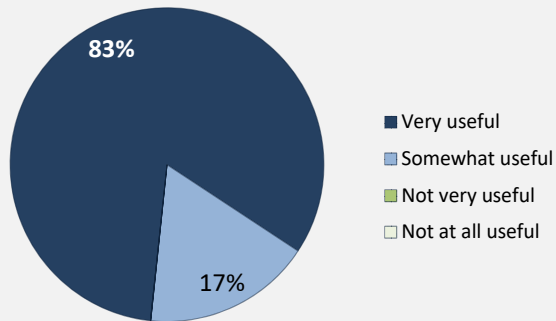

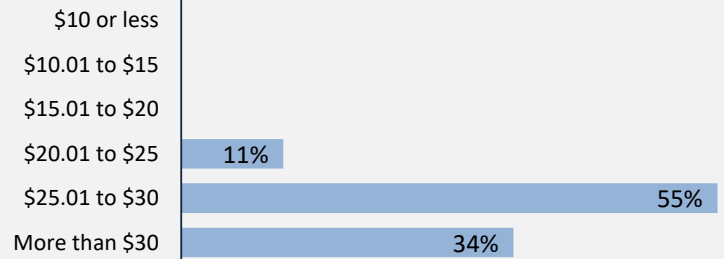

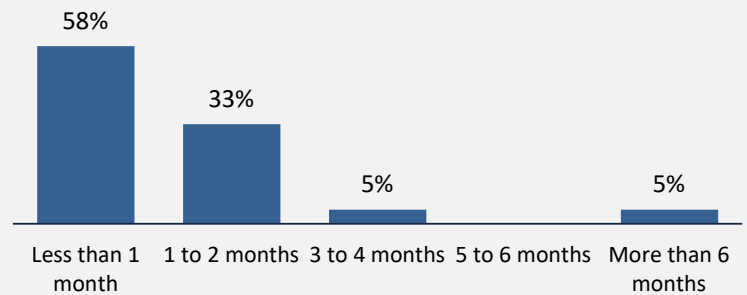
Skills and Knowledge Gained Useful in Performing Job

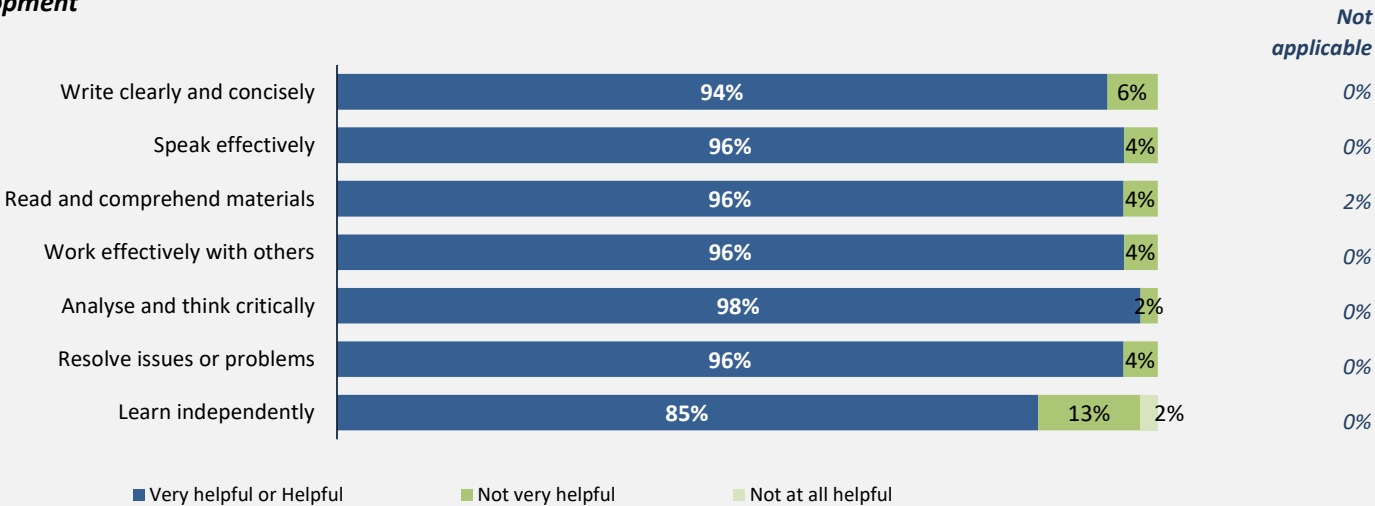

Skill Development and Post-Secondary Experience

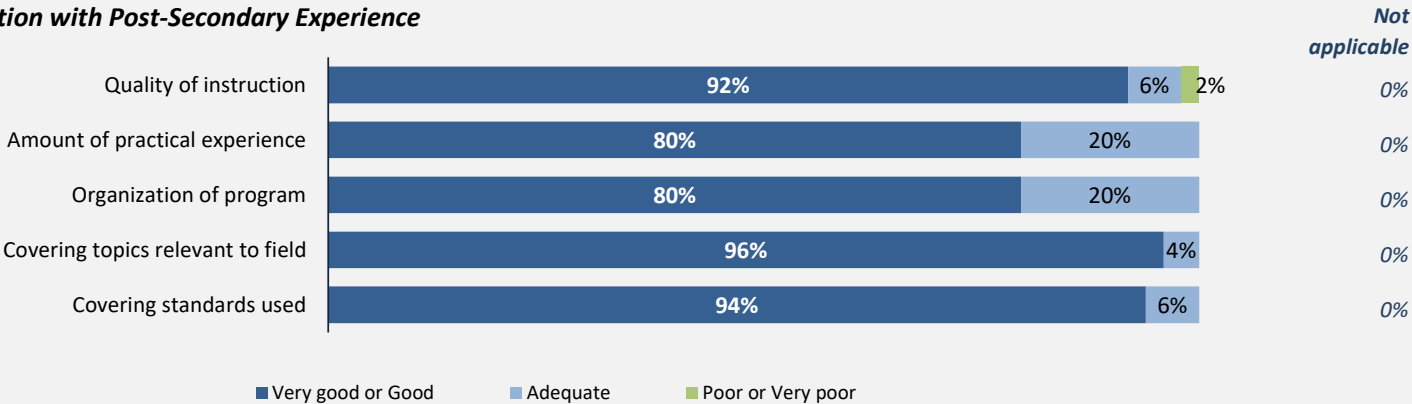
