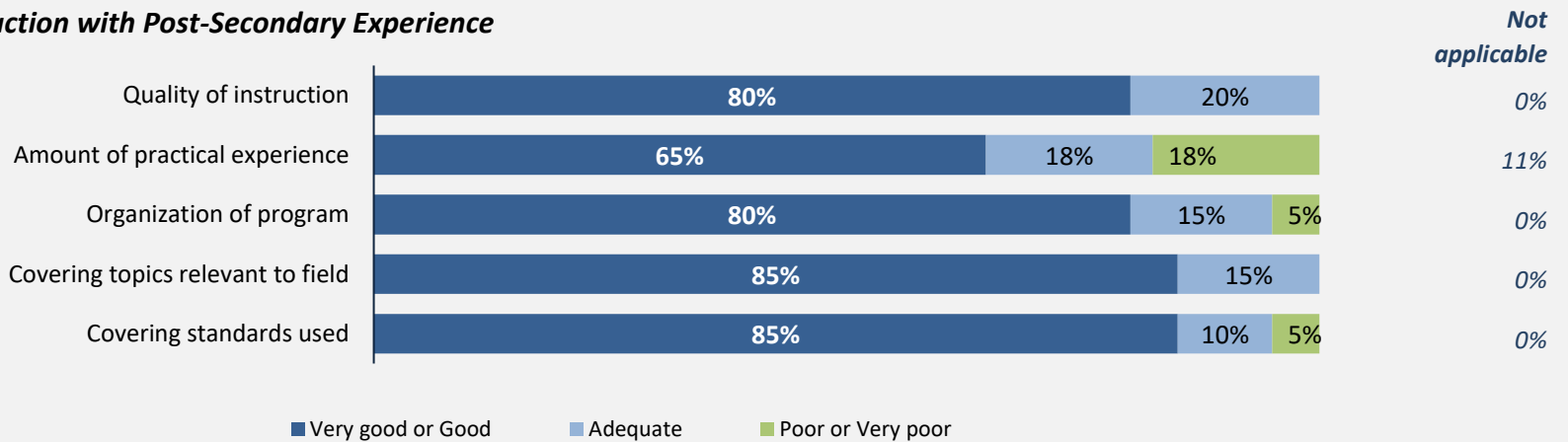

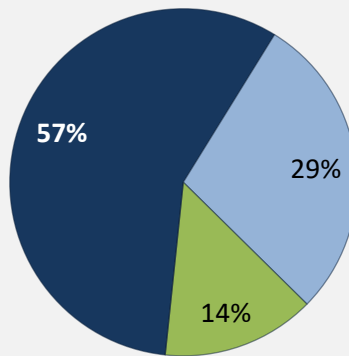

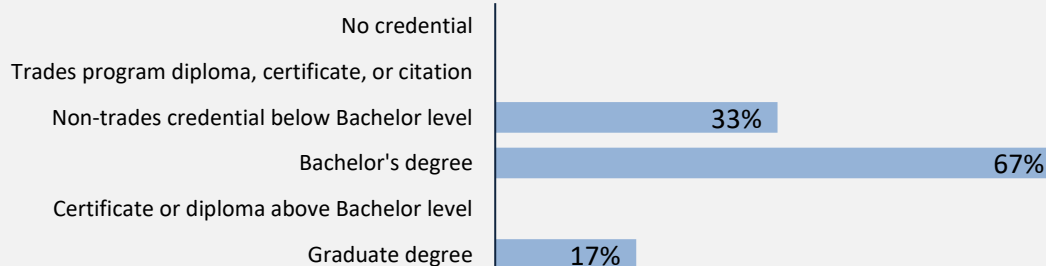

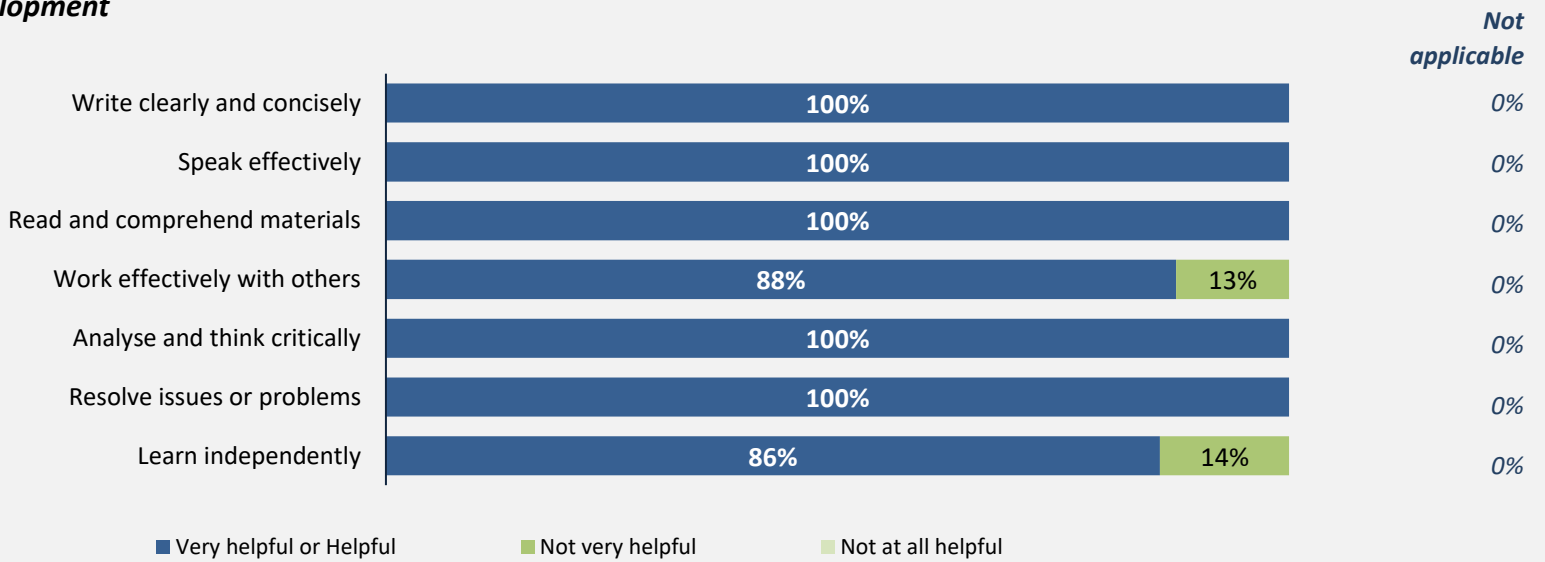

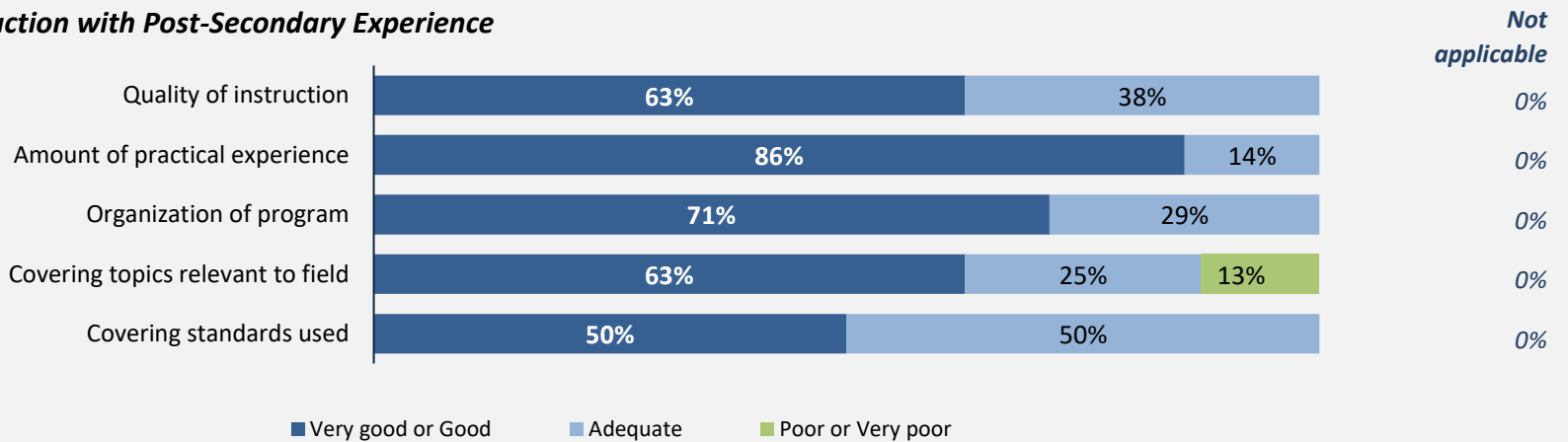

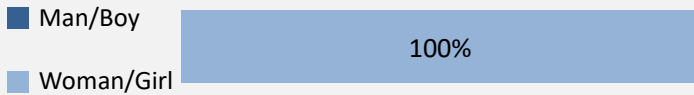

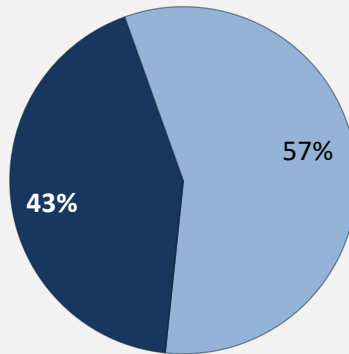

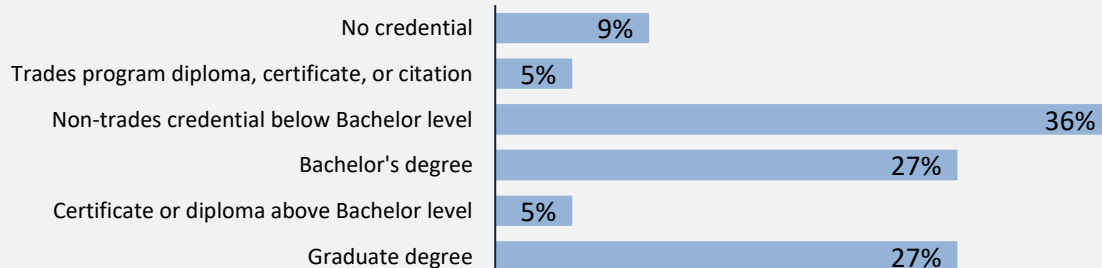

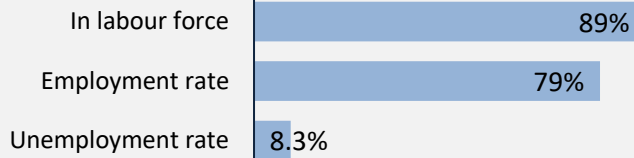

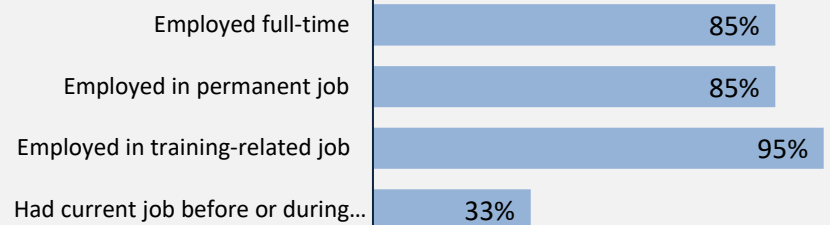

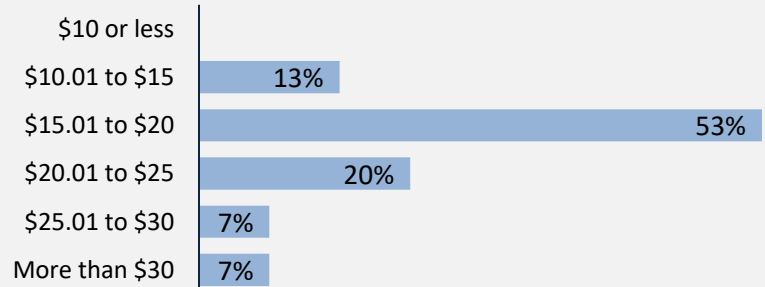
**Weekly Hours Worked (median, main job)**

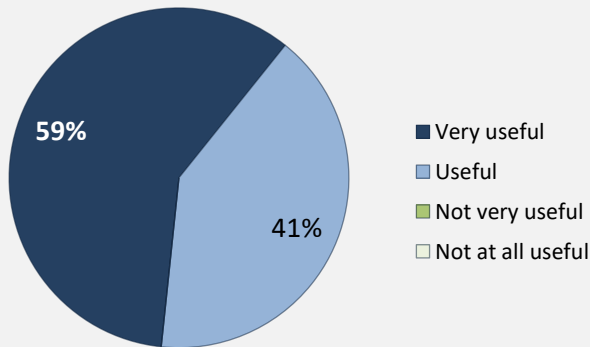

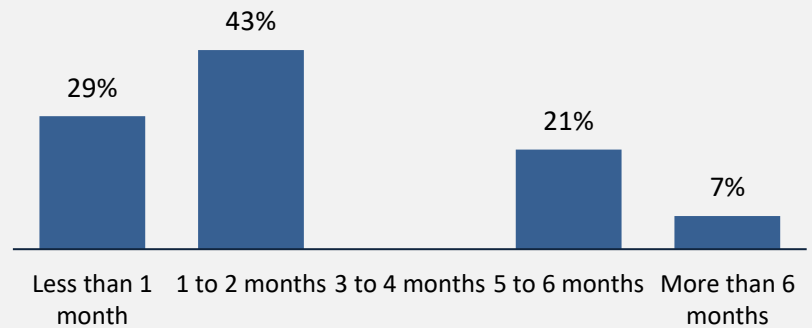

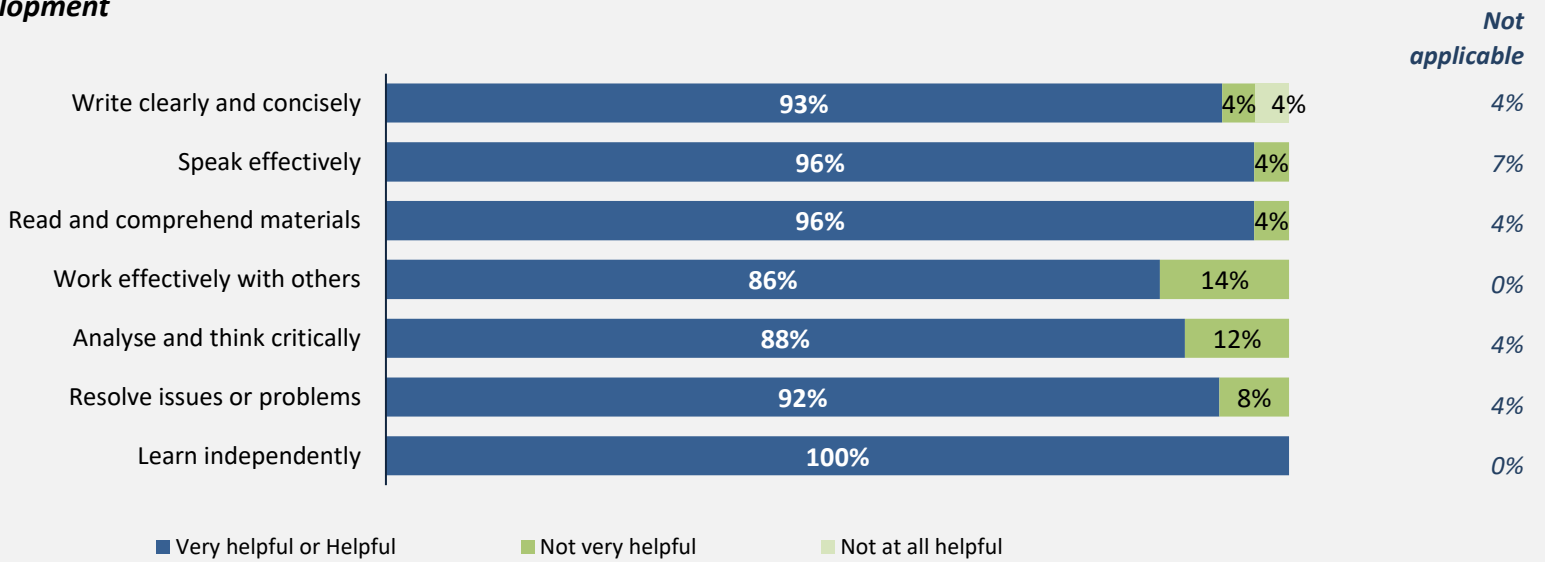

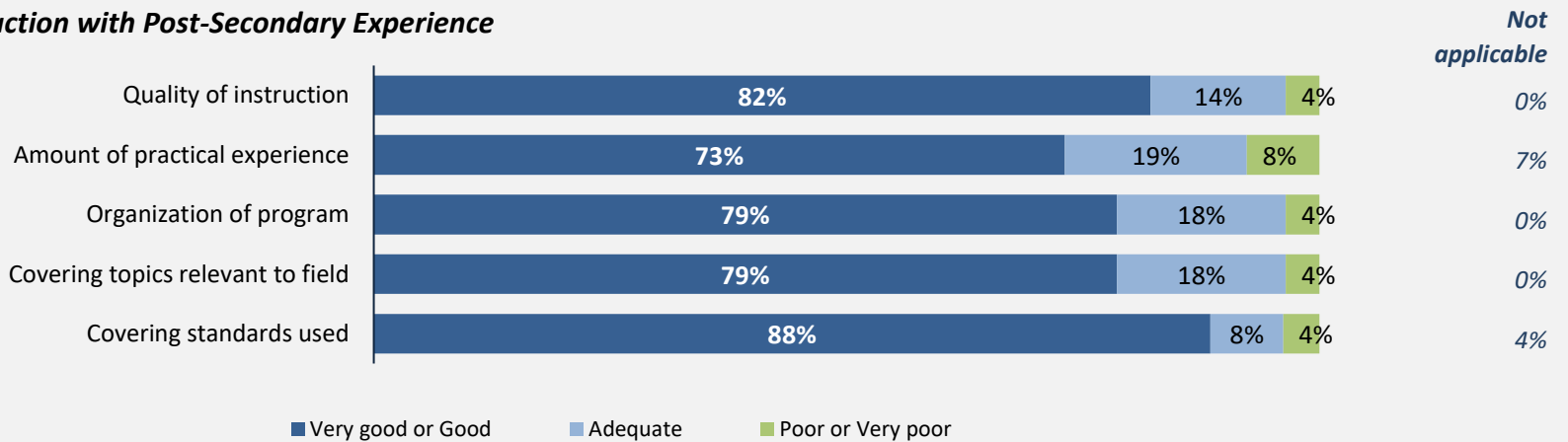

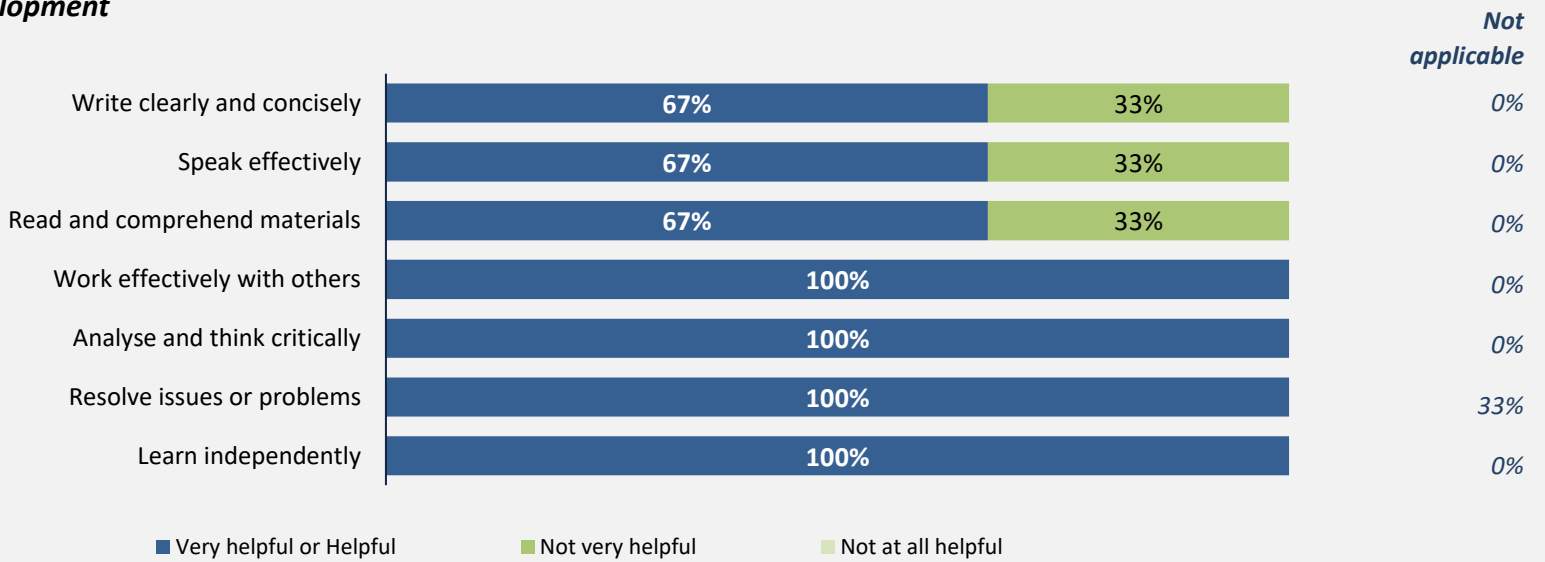

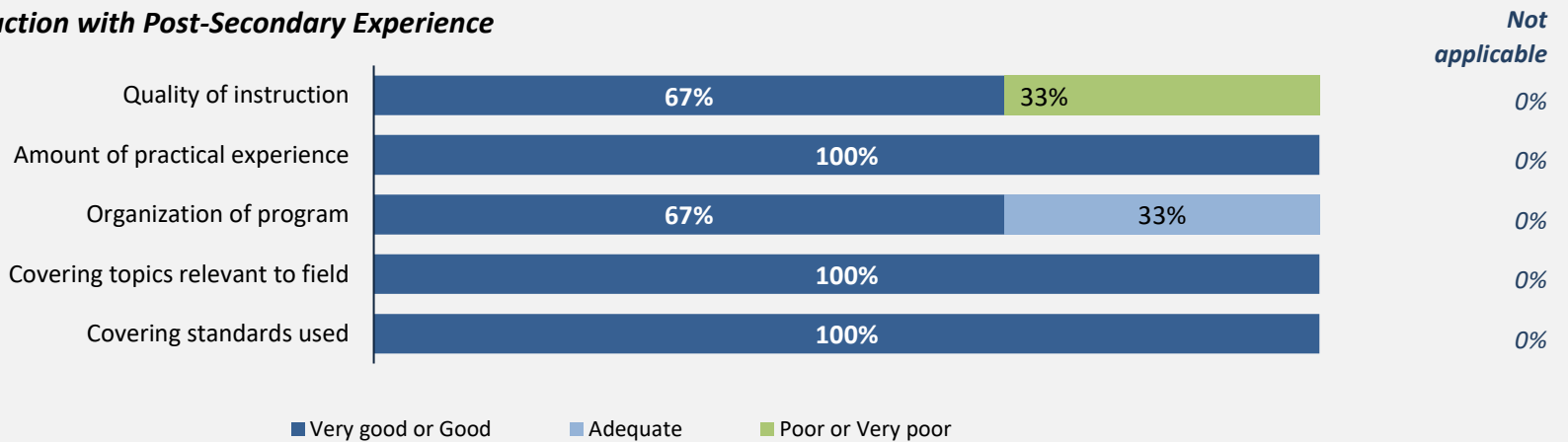
