Demographics



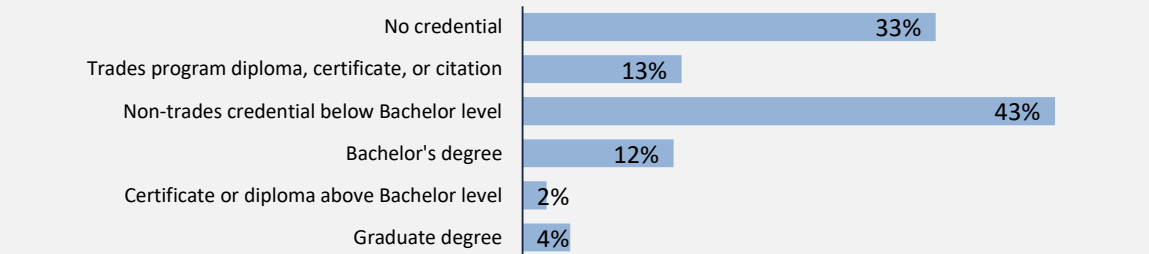

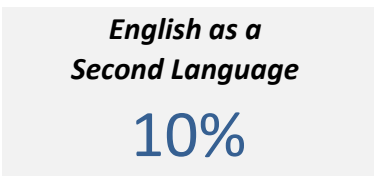
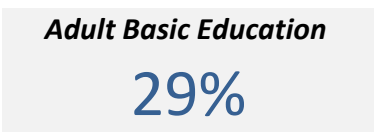

Respondents could report more than one type of post-secondary credential.

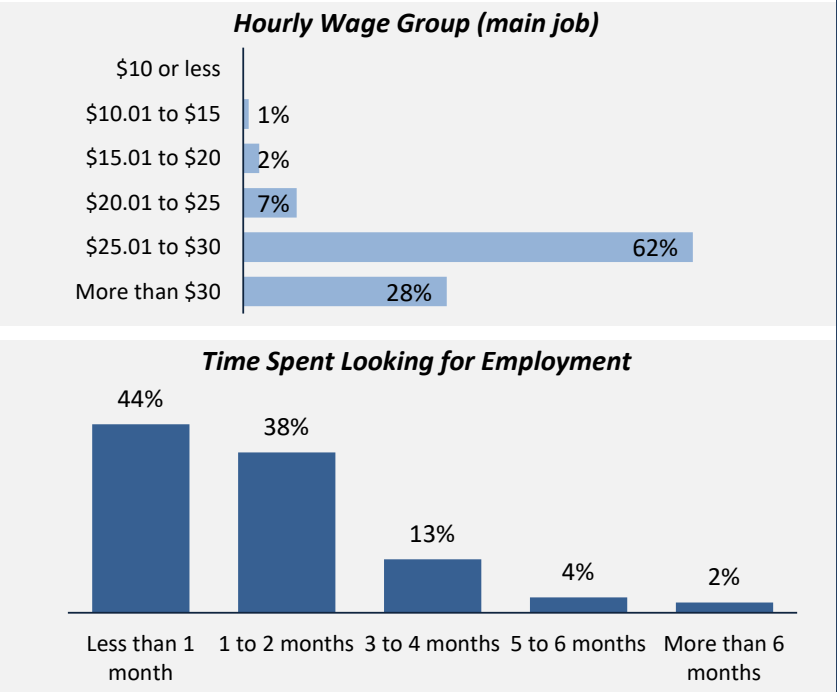
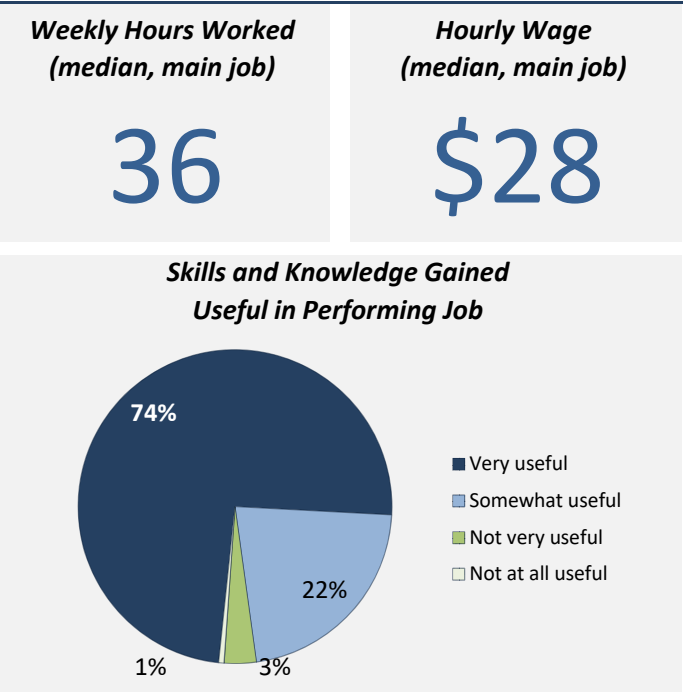
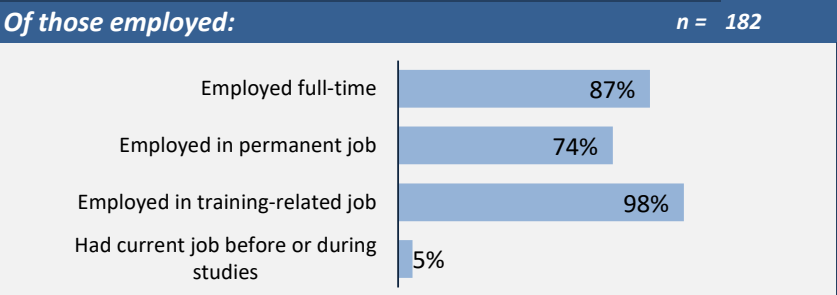
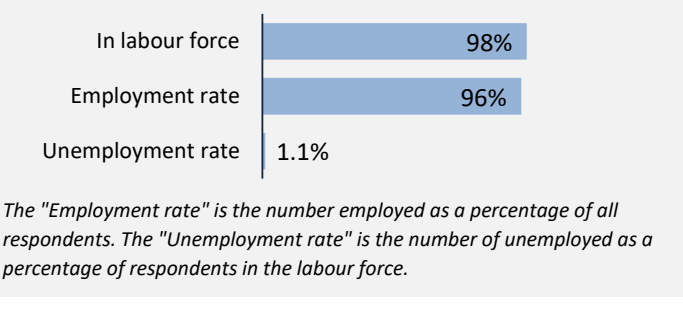

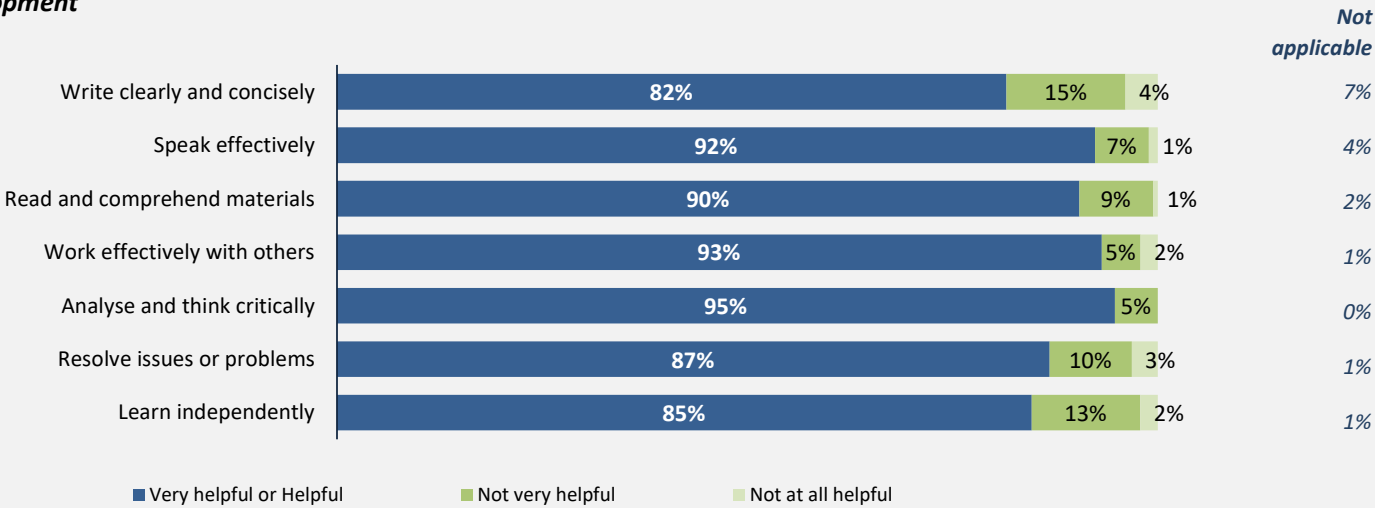

Skill Development and Post-Secondary Experience

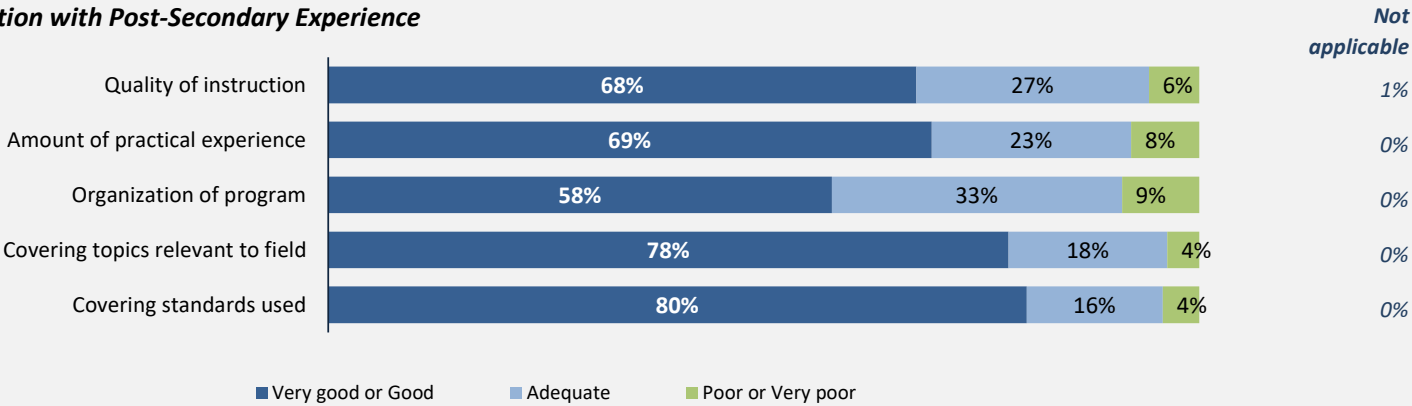
94% said they were very satisfied or satisfied with the education they received.
