### Program Description

The first-year University Transfer Engineering Certificate provides students with the opportunity to explore options and demonstrate success at the first-year level of university studies. This certificate is fully transferable to SFU’s Engineering Science Degree using the existing college transfer criteria for admission. Students may also attempt admission at other institutions such as UBC. The courses and GPA required for transfer to other institutions may vary at transfer.

### Graduate Outcomes

Graduates may apply to transfer courses to other post-secondary institutions in B.C..

### English Entrance Requirements

- English 12 with a C+ grade, or
- IELTS Academic overall 6.5 (with no band less than 6.0)
