Description

The Bachelor of Applied Music is a full-time program. A combination of classroom instruction, lab activities, rehearsals, performances, work experience, and practicum are included in the program. Students enrolled in the degree program specialize in classical, world, or jazz and contemporary music. In each of the four terms, students enroll in either classical voice or performance concentration. In the first two terms, students enroll in either Conducting or Creative Music Improvisation.

Admission Requirements

- Completion of a Music Diploma or equivalent with a minimum GPA of 3.0 (B) and a minimum A- in specialized performance or academic area is required prior to applying to this degree program
- English proficiency requirement:
 - Academic IELTS 6.5 (no band less than 6.0), or
 - TOEFL iBT 80 (Listening 20, Speaking 20, Reading 20, Writing 20)
- Two letters of recommendation (in a sealed, signed envelope) from people familiar with applicant's musical education and experience
- A written proposal to the School of Music, outlining goals and proposed program of work, and how the program will fit career aspirations
- Music Department [Audition](#): Students may send an audition DVD if they live outside of Vancouver
