OVERVIEW

The Computer Science & Software Systems certificate can be completed in 12-16 months. Options for graduates include:

- SFU Software Systems assured admission
- SFU Computer Science competitive admission
- UBC Computer Science competitive admission
- VCC Associate of Science degree program (1 additional year)

SFU ASSURED ADMISSION 2023-24 REQUIREMENTS

- Complete all coursework within 16 months
- Two terms of full-time study (12 credits)
- GPA of 3.2 or higher

Assured admission is for the Software Systems program; students can also apply to Computer Science at SFU (competitive admission).

Contact Advising for detailed requirements. Please note that international students are not eligible for assured admission to SFU.

TRANSFER TO UBC

BSC. IN COMPUTER SCIENCE

Same course requirements as SFU, plus one of PHYS 1100, CHEM 1121 or BIOL 1100. MATH 2700 is optional (but transfers as UBC STAT 241/251).

B.A. IN COMPUTER SCIENCE

Same course requirements as SFU, plus ENGL 1100. MATH 2700 is optional (but transfers as UBC STAT 241/251).

Admission to UBC is competitive.
