

Engineering (UT) course selection guide

The First-year Engineering certificate is a one-year program. Students must complete the program in sixteen months for assured admission to SFU. Otherwise, the maximum allowable time for program completion is three years.

Students applying to **UBC** must complete all coursework by the end of April for September admission.

Transfer options:

Students who complete the first-year Engineering certificate can apply to the second year of the following four-year Engineering programs:

- SFU - assured admission
- UBC Vancouver
- UBC Okanagan
- UVic
- UNBC
- TRU

SFU Assured Admission 2024-2025:

- Complete all coursework (40 credits) within 16 months
- Two terms of full-time study (12 credits)
- GPA of 2.7 or higher for Domestic Students, 3.0 or higher for international students
