DESCRIPTION

This course covers intermediate to advanced features of Adobe InDesign. In this instructor-led training, you will learn how to create interactive PDF files and engaging presentations; design, create and style tables; manage long documents with hundreds of pages and books with multiple chapters; create an automated table of content and index; manage styles, develop complex paths, advanced graphics; import and export data to external files; and create print-ready PDF files. Please note that this course is taught on a Mac. Students will have access to Adobe Creative Cloud for the duration of the course. For online learning, having a second monitor is very useful but not essential. You will learn through live demonstrations while interacting with a subject matter expert.
